TERMS OF PAYMENT

Terms: 30 days from date of invoice

TERMS OF BUSINESS

1. GENERAL terms of sale quoted below shall apply in all cases unless otherwise agreed in writing, and are binding upon the customer on acceptance of the quotation. In the event of a customer's conditions of purchase containing any clause at variance with these terms and conditions, these terms and conditions alone shall prevail.
2. QUOTATIONS shall expire 30 days after submission unless expressly agreed otherwise, and shall apply only to the specified units and equipment. Prices quoted are based upon costs of production at the date of quotation, and the company reserves the right to amend the quoted prices to take into account variations in costs during the execution of an order. Any clerical errors and omissions arising may be rectified by notice to the customer.
3. ORDERS will be accepted, acknowledged and executed with the reservation that no liability shall be attached to the company in the event of delay in execution due to force majeure, strikes, lock-outs, war and its consequences, import and export restrictions, unforeseen delay in the supply of raw material or other circumstances beyond the control of the company. Should an order be received after the expiry of the period of validity of the quotation, prices, delivery times, etc. may be adjusted in accordance with the conditions prevailing at the time of receipt of the order. Expenses incurred by the company through stoppage or delay in the execution of orders due to the customer's default may be added to the price quoted.
4. TIME OF DELIVERY is the estimated period from the date of receipt of the order together with all relevant information to the date of despatch of the goods from the company. No liability shall attach to the company arising from delay in delivery, nor shall such delay entitle a customer to cancel an order where such delay is due to force majeure, strikes, lock-outs, war and its consequences, import and export restrictions, unforeseen delay in the supply of raw material or other circumstances beyond the control of the company.
5. STORAGE OF GOODS. Detailed forwarding instructions must be received prior to the date of completion of the order. Should such instructions not be received within 7 days of this date, the company will place the goods in store and will reserve the right to charge for such storage until delivery is effected. In such cases goods are considered as having been despatched at the time they are placed into store, and the full purchase price is payable.
6. PACKING AND FREIGHT. Goods are packed for despatch according to the judgement of the company and the packages and containers are not returnable.
7. DEPOSITS

Retail Orders	Approximately 30 per cent of the value with order.
Overseas Orders	Approximately 50 per cent of the value with order. Work will not be commenced on any order on which a deposit is required until the deposit has been received.
8. RECLAMATIONS will not be entertained after the expiry of 6 weeks from the date of despatch of goods. Railed or shipped goods are sent insured. When received they should be signed for 'UNEXAMINED'. Damaged items should be returned promptly, every effort will then be made to replace them with a minimum of delay.
9. IMPORT LICENCES are the responsibility of the customer, who must forward the number and date of expiry of each import licence to the company in writing.
10. GUARANTEE. New equipment, delivered ex-works or through representatives of the company, will be guaranteed for a period of 6 months from the date of despatch against defects arising from inferior workmanship or construction. Such defects will be made good free of charge upon the return, carriage paid, during the period of guarantee, of the equipment to the company's premises. This guarantee shall not apply to components or fittings purchased from other manufacturers in respect of which only such guarantee as is given by the company's supplier is offered. The consequence of unskilled and incorrect handling of the equipment shall not be covered by the guarantee, nor shall the company be liable for expenses as the result of unauthorised alterations or repairs to suit any unit. Should such alterations or repairs occur, the guarantee covering the equipment will terminate. This guarantee does not exclude statutory rights and warranties.
11. CANCELLATION OF ORDER. In the event of an order being cancelled, for whatever reason, the company will be entitled to recover from the customer the cost of all work carried out and materials ordered at the date of cancellation, together with a sum equivalent to ten per cent of the contract price in lieu of profit.
12. LITERATURE. The right is reserved to effect alterations in any descriptions, printed matters, drawings, photographs etc. Copyright is reserved of all drawings, parts lists and descriptions.
13. The company reserves the right to accept telephone or telegraphic instructions relating to repairs/overhauls, but such instructions shall always be confirmed in writing the same day by the owners and marked "Confirmation". The company shall not be held responsible for any mistakes that may arise through the failure of the owner to submit detailed instructions in writing. The company shall not be responsible for consequential loss or damage arising from the owner's failure to ensure that the company is correctly and fully instructed on all repair/overhaul requirements.
14. The ownership of the goods to be delivered by the company will only be transferred to the customer where the customer has met all that is owing to the company. Nevertheless from the time of delivery the risk of any loss or damage to the said goods from whatever cause arising shall be borne by the customer.
15. In addition to any right of lieu to which the company may by law be entitled the company shall (in the event of the customer's insolvency) be entitled to a general lieu on all goods of the customer in the company's possession (although such goods or some of them may have been paid for) for the unpaid price of any other goods sold and delivered to the customer by the company under the same or any other contract.
16. The company shall not be liable for any consequential loss or damage upon failure of any goods or of equipment supplied at any delay in execution of work or in delivery from whatever cause save where such liability is imposed by statute.
