Subject: Moody 346 Refridgeration Unit

Date: 17th September 1991

- (1) Compressor unit is sited below shelf/locker base in starboard passage hanging locker, easily removeable through the locker opening.
- (2) Evaporator plate is under slung on a perspex shelf in the ice box.

## TO REMOVE

- (a) Uncouple joints to compressor unit
- (b) Unbolt evaporator plate from shelf
- (c) Uncouple thermostat sensor from evaporator plate.
- (d) Open up the access hole for pipework through icebox side
- (e) Move plate to far end of box as you feed pipe work back from compressor. Bring mouse back through with this pipework to feed new pipes through.
- \*(f) Feed thermostate sensor back through from icebox to locker again thread a mouse back through to aid return of new thermostat line (\*not required if thermostat is o.k.)
- (g) Run all new pipe work through and insert new evaporator and thermpstat\*
- (h) Bolt or screw units into position and couple up ensuring no gas is lost.
- (i) Make good all access holes.
- (j) Ensure any electrical connections are made by a competent person.
